The Saint-Affrique Greenway : a perfect route for discovering gravel riding in a picturesque countryside setting. And as a bonus, a little off-road “detour” on the way back !

To “get on track” with gravel riding, what better setting than a former railway line ? The Saint-Affrique Greenway is an easy, refreshing ride with no major difficulties, offering the perfect introduction to this versatile type of bike. After Saint-Jean-d’Alcapiès, a slightly rocky descent and a singletrack section add a few little challenges on the way back.

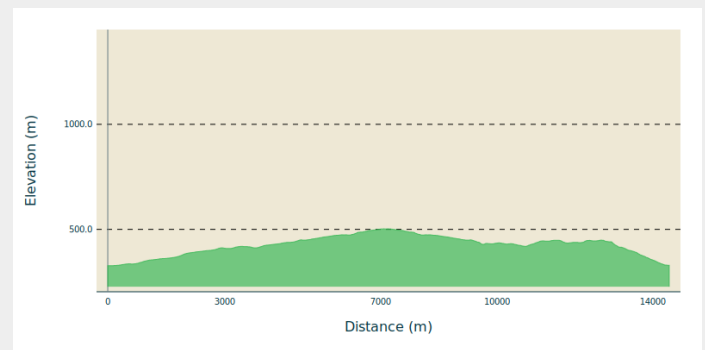

1. From the bike service station, take the greenway towards Saint-Jean-d'Alcapiès. You'll follow a beautiful shaded trail, ideal for getting your legs warmed up.
2. If you wish, take a short detour through the village's narrow streets, then turn back and begin your descent towards Saint-Affrique.
3. At the junction, descend to your left, then pass under the greenway to join the singletrack leading to Vailhauzy. Take care when crossing the RD999, then gradually follow the signs towards Saint-Affrique, alternating between small roads and singletrack.

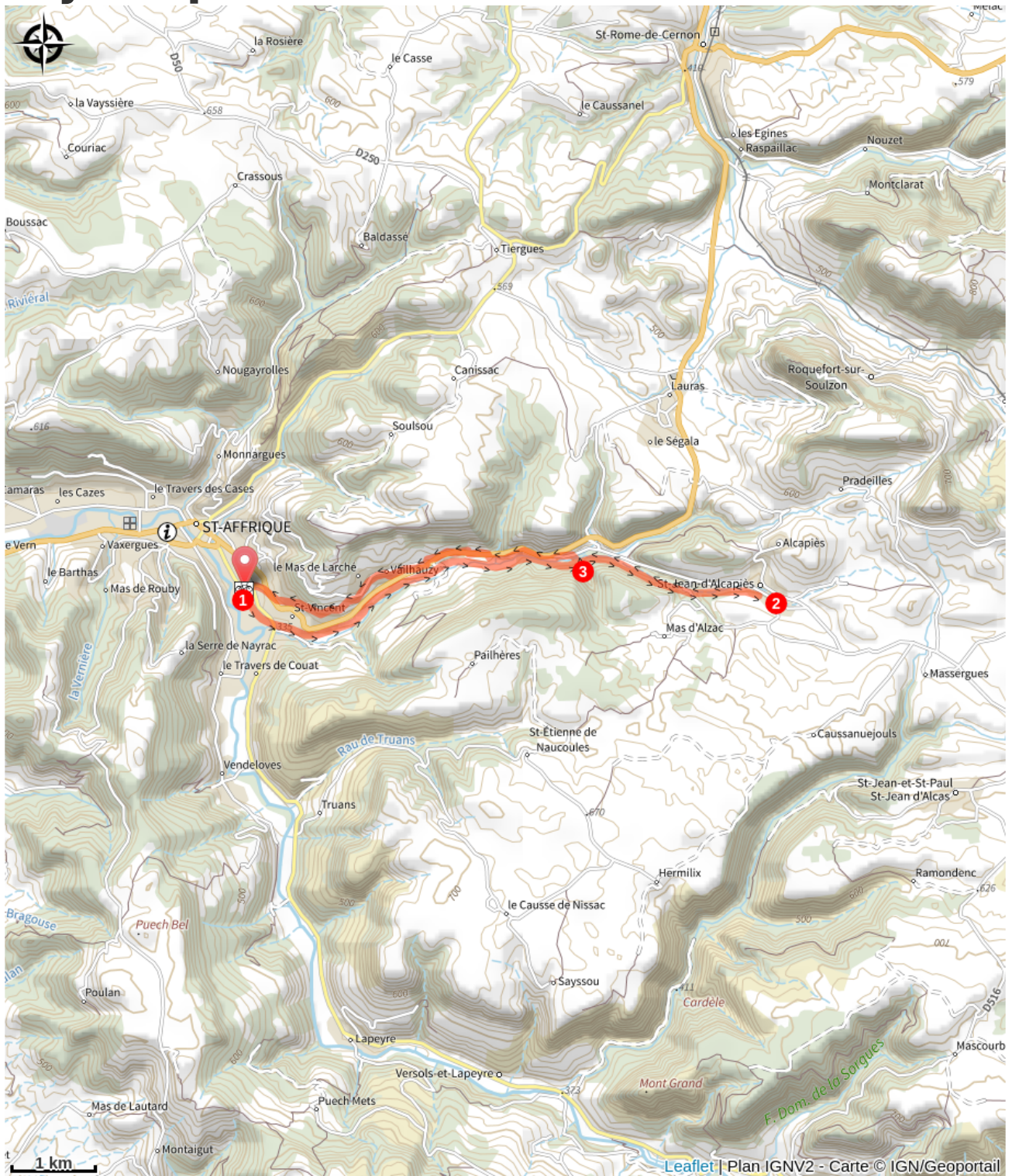
Technical sections :

- Short rocky descent : km 9.5
- Singletrack : km 9.75
- Main road crossing : km 10.7

5% roads and 95% trails

Riding time depending on your level : 45min to 1h15
